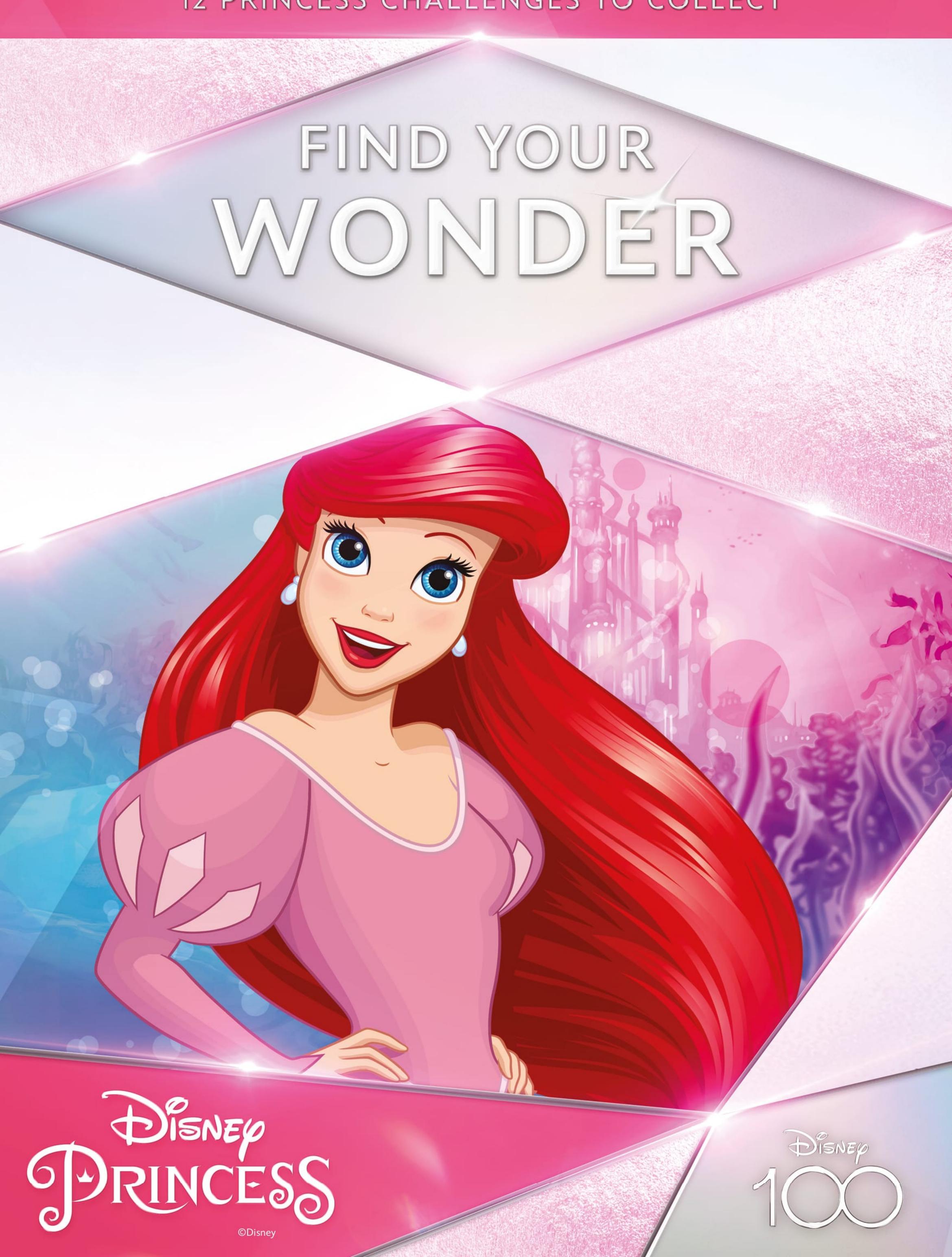
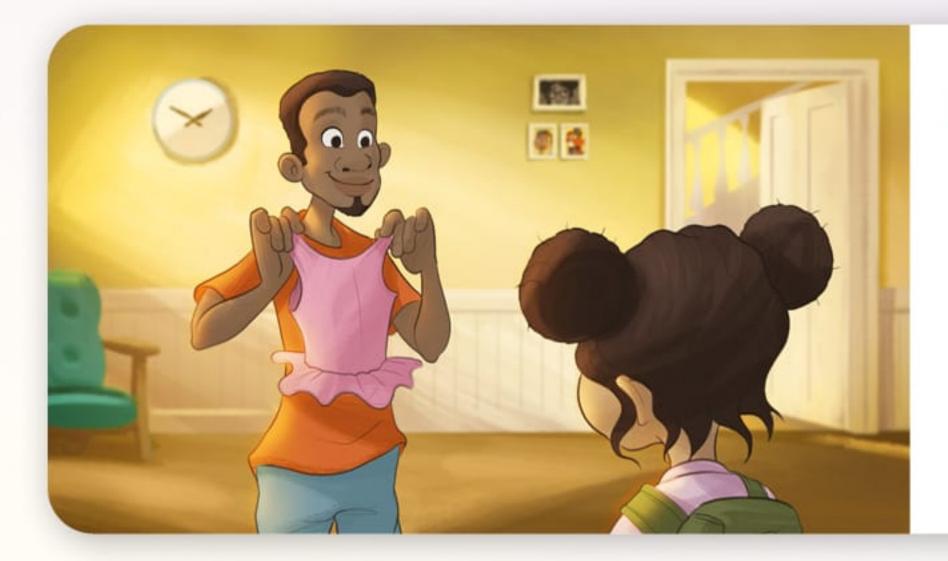
THE WONDER LIST 12 PRINCESS CHALLENGES TO COLLECT





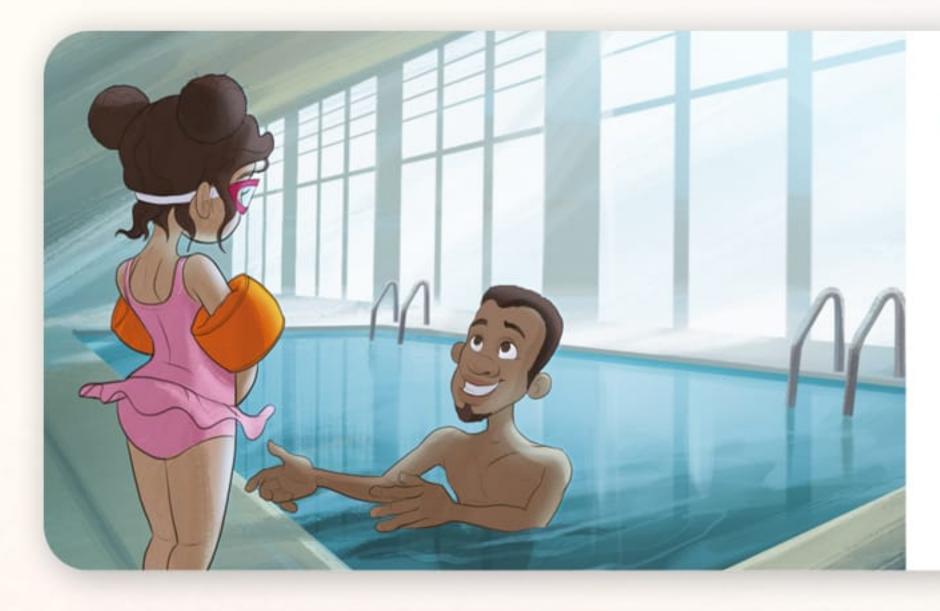
Complete this Wonder List challenge with Ariel!

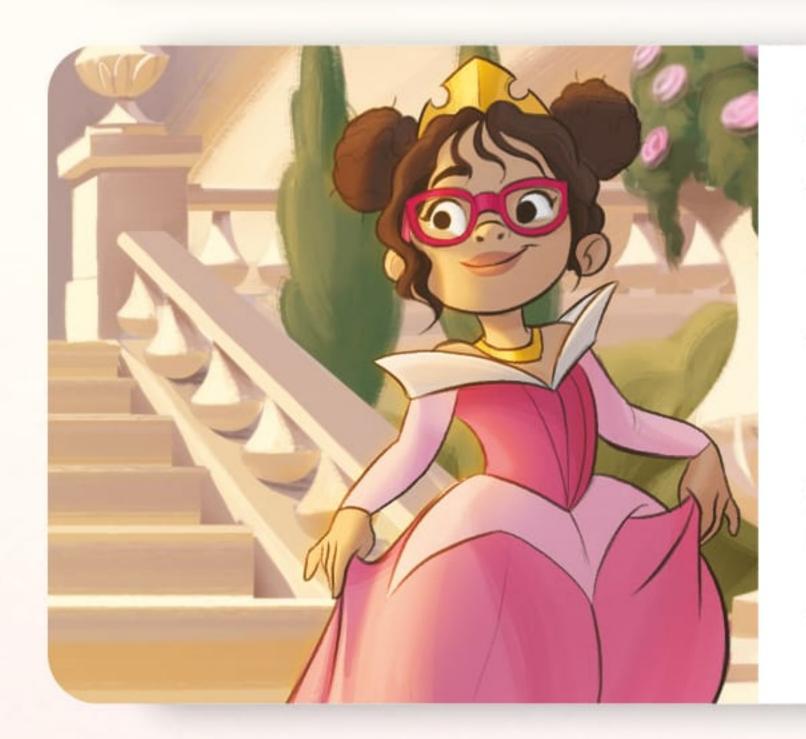
History is all around us; why not visit a nearby castle or stately home to learn about the lives of real-life Princesses?

Step 1: Hatch a plan!

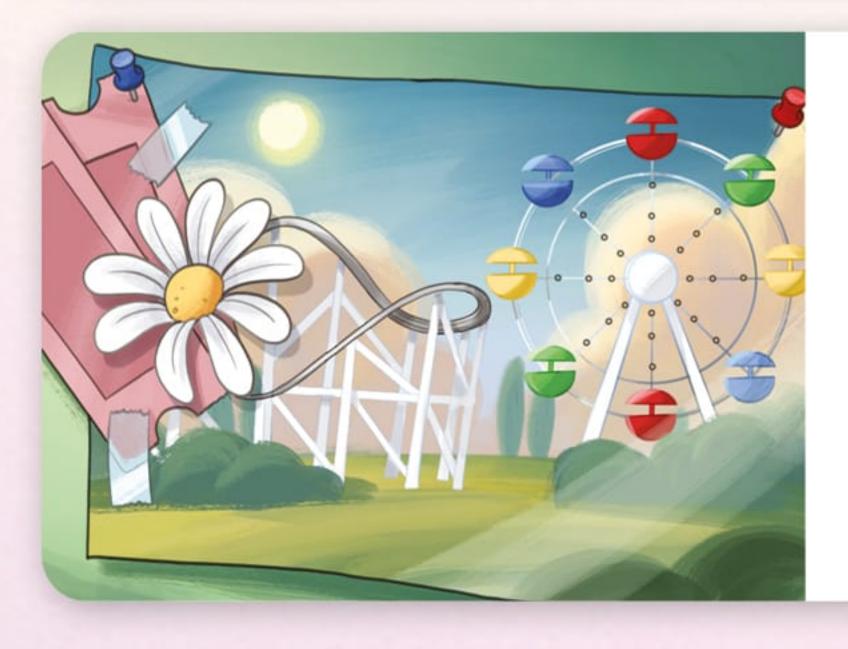
Have you been to the center of town? A museum? Tried indoor climbing or is there a local park or zoo you've never visited before?

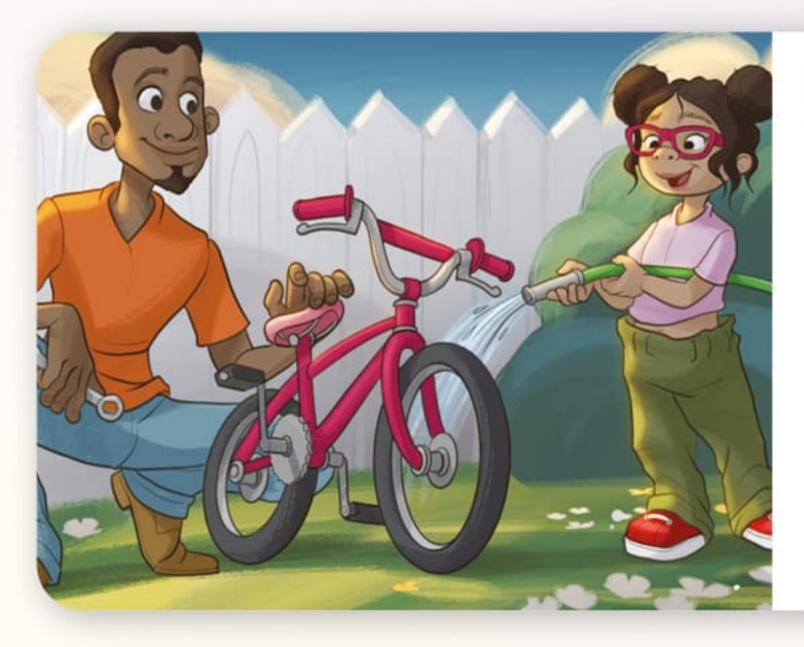






Complete this Wonder List challenge with Merida!

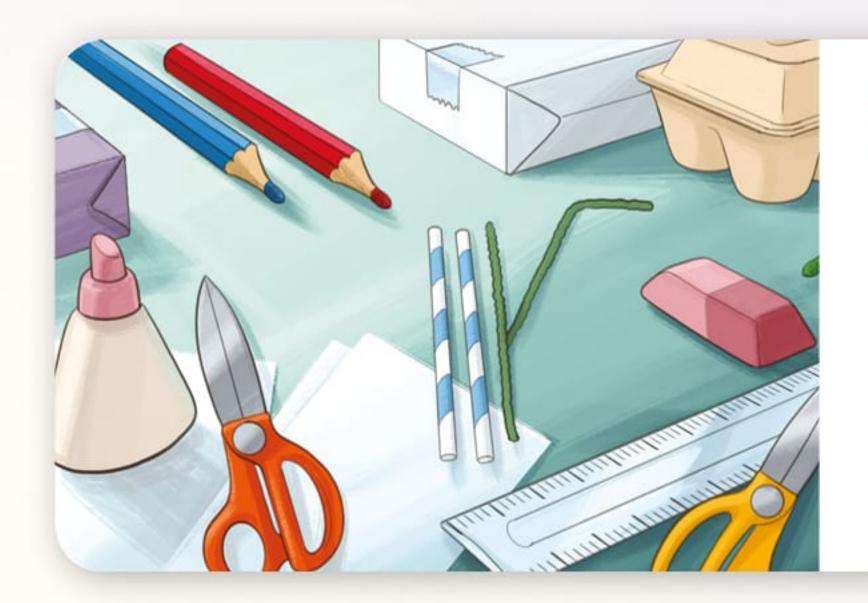

Complete this Wonder List challenge with Moana!

Make a model boat from things around the house and see if it floats. Just like Moana if it doesn't work, try again! Let's build on our curiosity, learn from our mistakes and go on an adventure!



Step 1: Grab your materials!

There's only one rule. Can it float? Have a look round the house or in the garden with you grown up.

You can use things like twigs, ice lolly sticks and egg cartons. Find other cool things to decorate your boat and make it seaworthy.



Step 2: Build the boat!

You can use string, sticky tape or glue to put it all altogether. Get your grown-up to help you with the tricky bits and make sure it's all secure and ready for a proper sea voyage.



Step 3: Set sail.

Okay you're all ready to set sail. With your grown-up fill a bath or go outside and find a little safe stretch of water. Let's see if your boat design works and don't forget to collect it after the voyage!

How long does it float for? How far does it travel? You could even challenge a friend or family member to a Moana boat race? Can you make it even better with a little sail, so it's powered by the winds.

Step 1: Make your Dragon!

Chat with your grown-up about what you can use.

Grab an old sock to start. You could sew in eyes and felt ears with the help of a grown up, glue cardboard and toilet rolls for wings and even some fire breathing tissue paper coming from its mouth.



Step 2: Practice makes perfect

Once your sock puppet is complete get your grown-up to shine a light onto a plain wall.

Practice moving your hand, breathing fire and make him talk, like Mushu. You can make him do anything!



Step 3: The show is on!

You can use cardboard to cut out trees, a Cri-Kee cricket or a Li Shang character to add to the show. Are you going on an adventure through the ancient lands of China or singing one of her songs? Ask grown-ups to watch the show and maybe film it so you can share with friends and family who couldn't attend. Let the show begin!

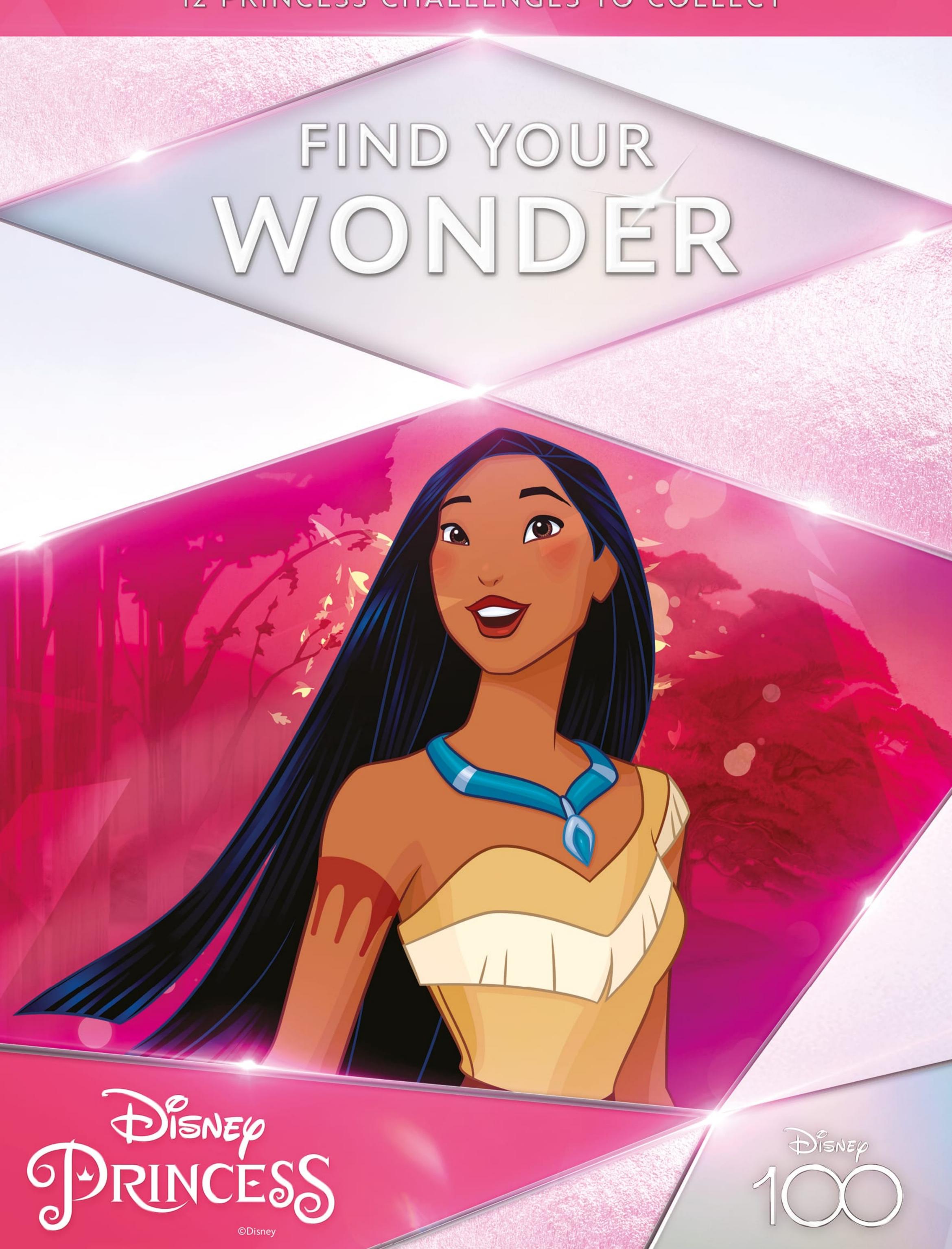
Dress up as Mulan and your hand can play Mushu.

When you get home make a wildlife journal.

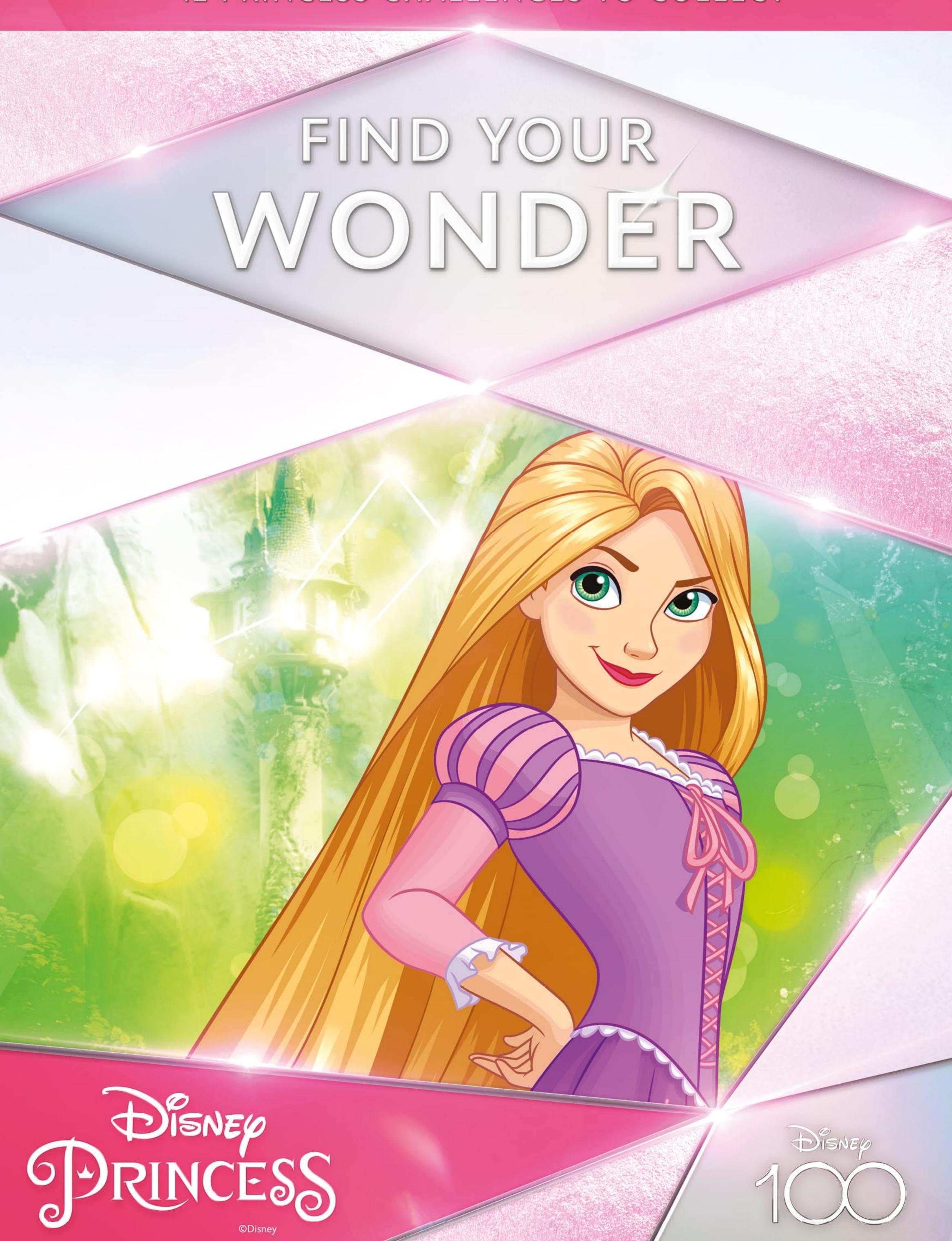
Think of all the animals you have seen.

Stargazing introduces a new world of stars, planets and even galaxies. Take some time to see the light in the night sky, like Rapunzel.



Step 1: Pack-up!

You are embarking on a mini adventure! Prepare with your grown-up by packing a blanket and a flask of your favourite drink.



Step 2: Find a spot!

With your grown-up, find a local place in a park, field or back garden.

Ideally somewhere with minimal light pollution so you can see all the stars.



Step 3: Find the brightest star...

Once you have found a spot, tilt your head back and look into the sky.

The longer you are outside the more you'll be able to see, as your eyes adjust to the dark.

What can you see?

- The brightest star is called Sirius. It's very close to the constellation of Orion. Can you see it?
- $\langle\!\!\!\!/$ Look out for any shooting stars or even planets. They all shine in the night sky.
- What colors are the stars? Some might be bright and white, others might be orange. A reddish looking star could be the planet Mars.

Why do animals love Snow White so much? Learn some fun tips on caring for pets or making your environment super friendly for wildlife around you.



Step 1: Make a Princess pet bed.

Do you have a pet, or do you know someone who does? With your grown-up's permission make a cozy princess bed for them to hang out. You can use cushions, blankets or if the pet is smaller, tissue paper and straw.

Decorate it in the style of your favorite Disney Princess with some pictures and fluffy toys.



Step 2: Make a bug park.

Create a little place in your garden to attract all sorts of cool insects. Put some water down, little twigs and leaves to make it cozy and even some left-over fruit for a juicy meal.

You can attract ladybirds, worms and even butterflies with your wildlife feeding station.



Step 3: Go nuts bird feeder!

Make a simple bird feeder using an old bowl or plate. Leave out nuts and fruit in the garden or on a windowsill and see who visits.

There's lots of interesting birds, squirrels and other little furry animals that will always be happy for a little meal.

Why not write a list of all the wildlife or types of birds you see and even draw pictures of them?



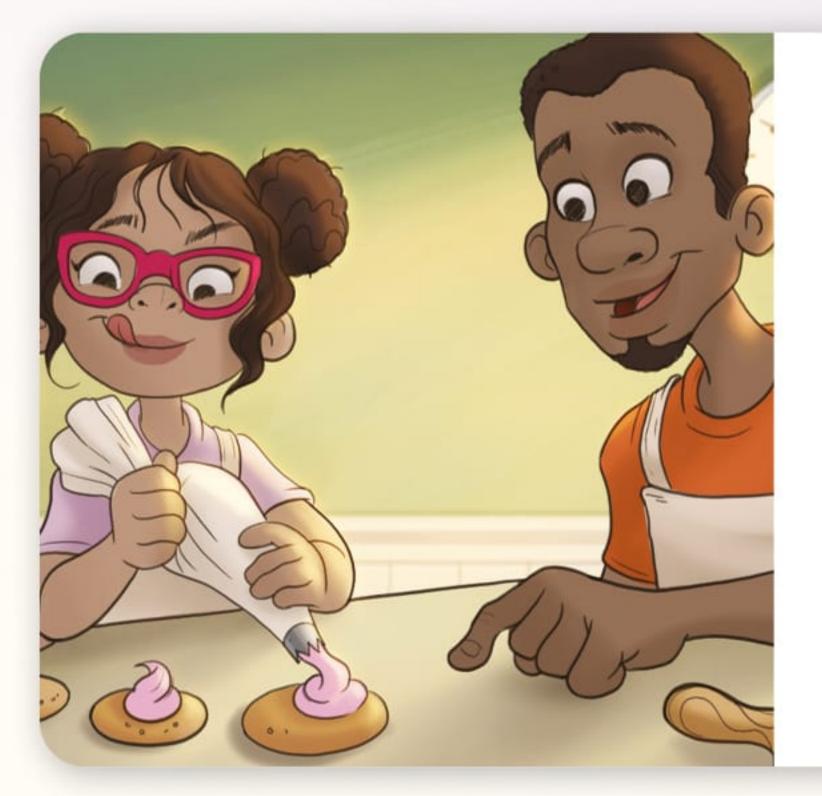

Step 1: It's Baking time!
